Walks 2018

Our 10am Saturday morning walks are very varied – something for everyone. Most are about 4 miles long and will take about 2 hours. We've graded them:

*Easy **Moderate
***Harder

At the end of each walk there's a named refreshment stop.

We may need to make changes, so please contact Ann or Sue for up-to-date information.

Suitable clothing and walking boots or shoes are needed (expect mud on most walks).

Walks are done at your own risk.

January 6

Millennium Coastal Path*

Meet in the Bynea Car Park. A very easy there and back coastal walk to The Wetlands. The path is alongside the beautiful Loughor Estuary with stunning views of Gower. Bring your binoculars for wild life spotting! (The Wetlands Coffee Shop)

February 10

Clyne Valley*

Meet at the Woodman Car Park. A walk through a maze of paths through this beautiful woodland with glimpses of the area's historical past (The Junction)

March 10

Dynevor Park**

Meet at Gowerton Train Station to catch the Heart of Wales Train to Llandeilo. After a coffee we'll explore some of the less well known parts of Dynevor Park, before returning to enjoy Llandeilo. The return train leaves at (Llandeilo)

April 8

Pontneddfechan Waterfalls

Meet at the Angel Inn, Pontneddfechan. A beautiful walk to Pont Melin Fach and back along the rivers Nedd and Fechan, passing spectacular waterfall. Some easy level walking but also some narrow, rocky, muddy sections. (Picnic lunch at Pont Melin Fach)

May 5

Parc le Breos**

Meet at Parc le Breos, Parkmill. A lovely walk including hillside, coast, stream, woodland, and, of course, beautiful views and mud. (Parc le Breos)

June 9

Cheriton/Ryers Down***

Meet at Cwm Ivy Car Park. A beautiful wooded Valley and stunning estuary views, then amazing cakes – plenty of rewards to make up for a steep climb and a slightly longer walk than usual. (Llanmadoc Village Shop)

July 7

Three Crosses/Berthlwyd **

Meet at The Poundffald. A walk through woodlands, fields and lanes with panoramic views of the Loughor Estuary. (The Poundffald).

September 8

Cefn Bryn **

Meet at The King Arthur. A figure of eight walk to King Arthurs Stone, across the top of Cefn Bryn, then back on the lower path. Fantastic 360 degree views of the Loughor Estuary, Oxwich Rhossili Down (King Arthur)

October 6

Port Eynon//Overton **

Meet at Port Eynon Car Park. A lovely varied walk – beach, cliffs, lanes and dunes – to the Salt House, Overton and Horton. (The Ship)

November 10

Mumbles Hill *

Meet at The Pier Car Park. A walk to explore the wartime relics on Mumbles Head as the sweep of Swansea Bay is revealed. Steps and a climb to start but then it's very easy. (Beach Hut Cafe)
