Walks 2020

Our Saturday morning walks are very varied – something for everyone. Most are circular walks, about 4 miles long and will take about 2 hours. We've graded them:

*Easy **Moderate ***Harder

We leave Three Crosses (Pantydwr) at 9.15 to travel to the start point of each walk.

An outline of the walks follows and further details will be emailed to those on our mailing list about a week before each walk.

A coffee/cake stop, usually at the end of the walk, is given.

We will also let you know, by email, of any changes that we need make to the programme.

Suitable clothing and walking boots or shoes are needed (expect mud on most walks).

We have also included an extra mid week walk.

All walks are done at your own risk.

January 11th

Loughor Estuary & Castle

Start – Loughor Boat Club. Blow away the Christmas and New Year cobwebs! An easy walk with estuary views and some history. (Loughor Boat Club)

February 8

Margam Pulpit **

Start - Margam church. Explore Margam Park including a walk up to the old church (Margam Park Visitor Centre)

March 7

Hardings Down**

Start – Kings Head, Llangennith. Fields, tracks and moorland with stunning views. (Kings Head)

April 4

Clyne Woods & Gardens**

Start – Clyne Castle Car Park. Clyne Valley and the spectacle of Rhododendron and Azalea time in Clyne Gardens. (DIY)

May 9

Priors Wood & Dunvant**

Start Three Crosses (Pantydwr). Bluebells in Priors Wood, the common, lanes, fields and less familiar views from our village area. (Poundffald)

June 6

Pwll Du**

Start – Southgate NT car park. To Pwll Du via Bishopston Valley and a cliff top return. Some mud but stunning scenery. (Jamie's, Southgate)

Plus June 3, or 10 or 24 (Weds)

An extra mid week walk to see the spectacular and rare orchids at Kenfig Burrows.

July 4

Llanmadoc & Landimore***

Start - Cwm Ivy car park. Woodland, marsh, estuary views, fields and lanes. (Village Shop, Llanmadoc for the best cakes in Gower!)
